1 "(l)(1) The aircraft inventory of the Air National 2 Guard shall include not fewer than 25 fighter aircraft 3 squadrons each of which shall have a minimum of 18 pri-4 mary aircraft authorized. 5 "(2) The Secretary of Defense may waive the requirements of paragraph (1) with respect to individual aircraft 6 if the Secretary— 8 "(A) certifies to the congressional defense com-9 mittees that compliance with such requirements is 10 not feasible due to extraordinary circumstances; and 11 "(B) includes with such certification an expla-12 nation of such circumstances.". 13 SEC. 3. PLAN ON FIGHTER FORCE RECAPITALIZATION. 14 (a) Plan Required.—The Secretary of the Air 15 Force, in consultation with the Director of the Air National Guard, shall develop a fighter aircraft recapitaliza-16 tion plan that provides for— 17 18 (1) the replacement and modernization of Air 19 National Guard fighter squadrons at a rate that 20 shall ensure the full, one-for-one, recapitalization of 21 Air National Guard fighter squadrons by the end of 22 fiscal year 2034; and 23 (2) the fielding of the Next Generation Air 24 Dominance family of systems in the Air National 25 Guard.
